Having returned from the holiday and seeing so many happy faces on Monday 31st of October, we were surprised, nervous and pleased all at once when we received our call from Ofsted to say that Willow Dene's long awaited Section 5 inspection would take place on the 2nd and 3rd of November. For two days our inspection team looked in enormous depth at all aspects of our practise.

We would like to say a huge thank you to all of you who supported us by completing the parent questionnaire, speaking to inspectors and sending us the most lovely messages of support. We were extremely grateful to be surrounded by our Willow Dene community and uplifted by your encouragement. Hopefully you've had the chance to watch our parents briefing and will know that we are currently awaiting the final outcome, which can take approximately 15 days from the date of the inspection. Whatever the outcome is, we are and will remain very proud of our school. When we hear anything you will be the first to know.

We are very happy that this Christmas there are lots of opportunities for Willow Dene families to be part of school life and get involved. You will soon be receiving our Christmas dates, which will tell you when we will be having our parties, visits from Santa and performances. Hopefully this year they will be COVID free and unrestricted and we will make the most of this!

You may also have seen our flyers encouraging families to join our search for Willow Dene's next Star Baker with the Festive Bake Off Challenge and an opportunity for brothers and sisters to join our sibling competition, celebrating the many brilliant relationships our children have with their brothers, sisters and other relative. These have included a MOVE group, where

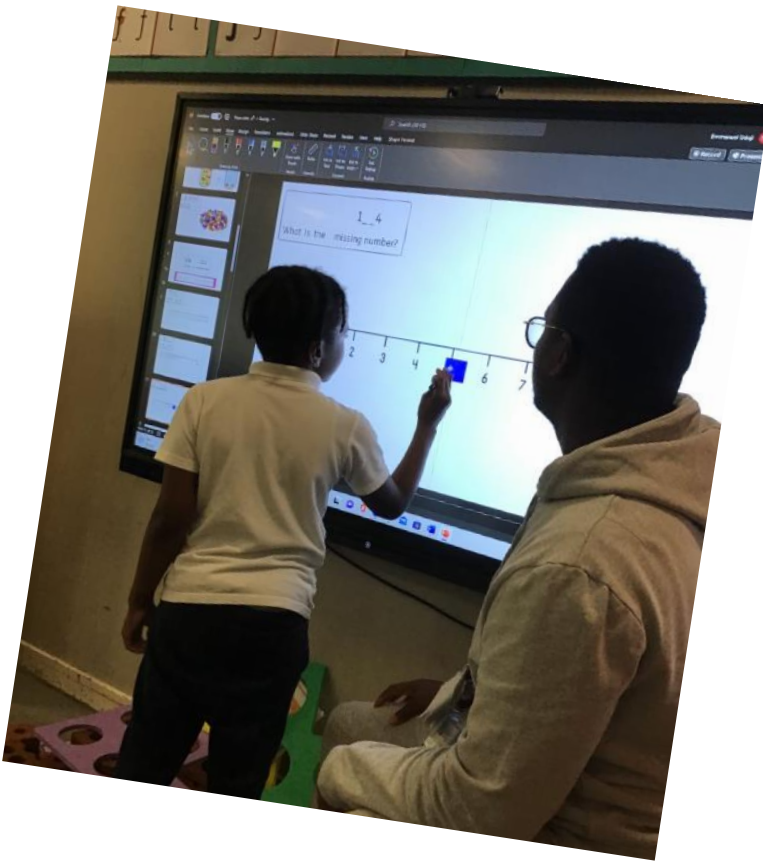

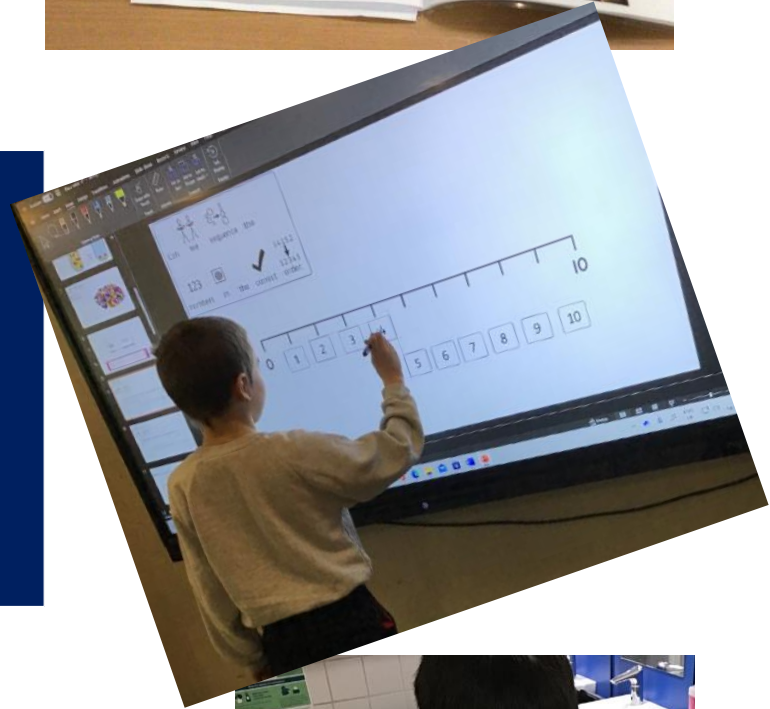


Starling Class

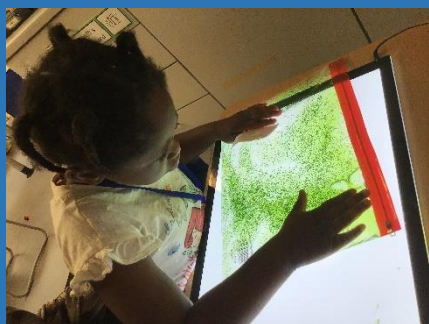
As Starling Class return for Autumn 2, we introduced an exciting way to add and subtract numbers in numeracy using different resources.

Our favourite sensory based activities were most certainly exploring shiny and translucent materials on top of the light box, exploring sounds and vibrations by dropping materials on top of a giant drum, and tasting different textured and flavored condiments, sauces and dips to discover our preferences.
