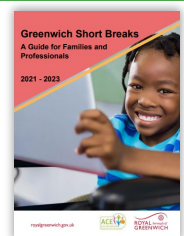

the guide.

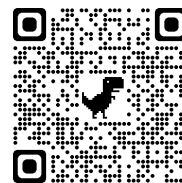


Holiday Food and Fun is back for this half term

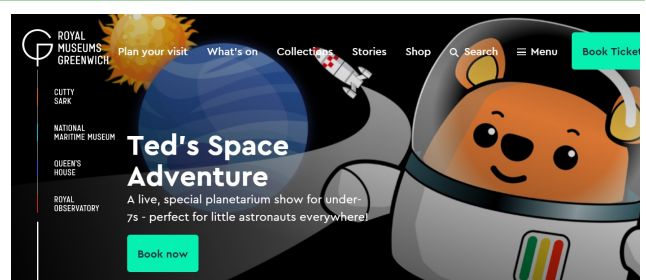

As a local area partnership, we have created a series of videos to provide information, strategies and support for families with ASD as well as those with a child on the ASD assessment pathway. Families have told us that they need more support whilst they wait for diagnosis and immediately after. 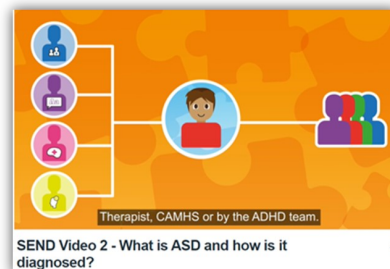
